

# **How It Began**

We launched the Lumière Project in 2015 with the twin goals of:

- reaching 6 million children and youth with God's Word and
- seeing 3,300 new churches planted in French-speaking Africa.

By 2024, our partners have planted over 3,900 new churches with an attendance of more than 5 million people.

We have now expanded on the goals of the project to include a church plant in every village across the continent.

## **How It Works**

With your congregation's support and prayers, OneHope is committed to the local church and works with them to deliver the Scripture programs for children and youth. Then our local church partners send teams with the Word for young people in new villages, and from there, they plant churches.

- Over 100 denominational groups are partnering with us to plant churches.
- Over 100 different languages are spoken among the church plants.
- Young people under the age of 21 accounted for over half (59%) of the overall church attendance.

This is a proven strategy for leading children and youth to Jesus and establishing church fellowships where they and their families can grow in the faith. Our partner



pastors and churches are:

- Showing The GodMan film in village after village
- Sharing the Book of Hope and the illustrated cards of God's Big Story
- Preaching the Good News and planting churches

We've forged incredible partnerships with local pastors and churches. This is a proven strategy to reach the next generation across a difficult region and plant new churches where Islam is on the march.

#### **DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO:**

## **Rocky's Story of Transformation**

In a rough neighborhood of Kinshasa, young Rocky was known for his mischief and petty crimes. He and his friends carried knives, were stealing, and causing trouble. The community viewed them as a threat rather than as children.

Rocky went to a OneHope program at church with a plan to act up and disrupt the services — he expected to be rejected and instead was welcomed in, despite his reputation. It was a rare experience of acceptance for the boy.

Today Rocky is following Jesus — and he's a regular at church. He and his friends have found a safe haven where they can grow in faith and leave their troubled past behind.

## Wheelchair & Witness — Meldon's Tale

Meldon was among the many children who came to see an outdoor showing of *The GodMan* film — and he chose to dedicate his life to Christ! With joy, he received the invitation to come to Sunday school and the local church ...

But as the team packed up the projector at the end of the event, they noticed Meldon still sitting on the ground ... and realized: he is disabled and can't walk. He was waiting for a family member to come and collect him.



ur partners in many nations of Africa are threatened with persecution because of radical Islam — but God's Word still makes inroads.


