



## SUMMARY

Despite the strong presence of Buddhism, Taoism, and Islam, ministry in this region is flourishing and doors of opportunity continue to open each year. However, traditional religions are still prevalent and are often influenced by Polynesian traditions.

The Asia Pacific region is one of OneHope's most diverse areas in terms of geography, population, and culture diversity. The countries that comprise this region account for approximately 1.1 billion children and youth that will need to be reached with God's Word in fulfillment of Vision 2030.

## ONEHOPE HISTORY

With the Philippines being the first nation in this region to have the *Book of Hope* distribution, it has become the launching pad and paved the way for other nations. Given the diversity of this region, the history of each country has taken several distinct paths. In countries where the legislative environment and the church readiness was there, our ministry was launched quite rapidly. In countries where this was not the case, we have navigated the situation slowly, exploring new ministry models or waiting for an opportunity.

## TESTIMONY

Nyunt lives in a predominantly Buddhist country where Christians are often persecuted and treated as traitors. But when Nyunt received the *Book of Hope* and began attending a Bible club at a local church, he learned the truth about Jesus. And he chose to follow Christ as Savior!
